3. Grant applications for Chamber projects: \$25,000 for Festival and \$5000 for Welcome Kit from Dept State and Regional Development in 2006-8
4. Fundraising events showcasing local businesses: Annual Ball, Coaching Café, B2B EXPO etc
5. Riverside Art Walk – a developing tourist attraction that provides an opportunity for local artists to display/erect their work in the public arena
6. Business opportunities - including networking meetings, DSRD, Council, Hunter Business Advisory Service, TAFE, Small Towns Big Ideas Committee
7. Ongoing review of development plans - of proposed developments and other issues that affect our community (Housing Strategy, Marine Park, Highway Overpass etc)
8. "Coaching Café" Business Coaching
